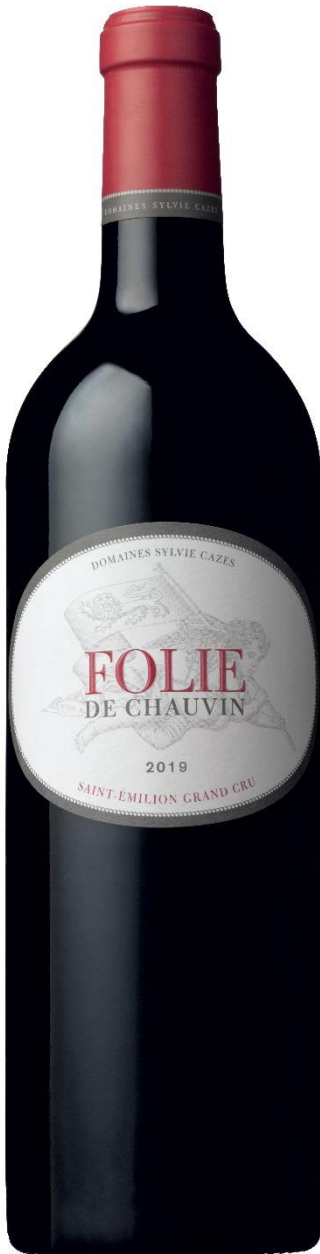

"The suppleness of the fruit on the sapid and digestible dimension of Cabernet Franc associated with the sands and limestones of the North-West part of Saint-Emilion, establishes the wine on the basis of this warm, well-balanced vintage. The assembly work is particularly careful to give this second wine its tasty identity in the style of Chauvin. Good length, easily digestible on a particular tension."
